

# **Creekside Ward Mission Plan**

## **Purpose**

1. Encourage ward members to invite others to come unto Christ and learn of His restored gospel
2. Offer ward members specific activities that will help them accomplish this purpose

## **4 Invitations to Ward Members**

**Purpose: Enable us to find individuals and families who are ready to serve in the church**

1. **Create a written family mission plan**
2. **Pray daily to find and invite someone to meet with the missionaries in your home by a specific date**
3. **Invite someone not of our faith to serve with you or your family in a church or community activity**
4. **Minister faithfully**

1. **Assign a monthly talk on missionary work**
2. **Hold a regular sacrament meeting that is intended for visitors or returning members**
3. **Plan a monthly organized service opportunity**

#### **4 Invitations to Ward Members (What ward members will see)**

##### **5. Create a written family mission plan**

*Description: Create a plan that might include some of the following invitations, goals to invite neighbors or friends to family home evenings, goals to bear testimony to friends, post inspirational content on social media, etc.*

##### **6. Pray daily to find and invite someone to meet with the missionaries in your home by a specific date**

*Description: The daily prayer might look something like: "Please give me the strength to recognize and invite someone to meet with the missionaries by July 31st of this year."*

##### **7. Invite someone not of our faith to serve with you or your family in a church or community activity**

*Description: People and families NEED opportunities to serve and feel wanted. The church offers a structured environment to meet this need. Invite an individual to help you cook a meal for a family that just had a baby, to help with a move, to help you prepare a talk by listening and giving feedback. Make someone feel like we need their help in our church because we do.*

##### **8. Minister faithfully**

*Description: Be a good minister and the Lord will inspire us on how to keep those we bring in*

#### **4 Invitations to Ward Leaders (What ward leaders will see)**

##### **5. Assign a monthly talk on missionary work**

*Description: A speaker is assigned to speak on the why and the how of missionary work.*

##### **6. Hold a regular sacrament meeting that is intended for visitors or returning members**

*Description: Pick, for example, the second sunday of every month or every fifth sunday to include talks on foundational doctrines of the restored gospel such as the restoration or the plan of salvation. Ward members and speakers know the second sunday is a great day to invite friends.*

##### **7. Plan a monthly organized service opportunity**

*Description: Community members want a place where they can serve and feel wanted. Providing monthly service will give members opportunities to invite. This could be a partnership thing as well, every second saturday ward members go clean the pioneer cemetery with members of another faith*

##### **8. Count the "ones" that aren't at church every sunday and not always the 99 that are there**

*Description: Ward leaders will provide the missionary committee with a list of those who attended sacrament meeting, so that the ward missionary committee can ask the question "who wasn't here that should have been or who needs to be". These names can then be brought to ward council as part of our weekly 5*

Ward Missionaries

1. Meet with ward families and help them create family mission plans and then follow up
2. Meet with ward families to help them implement the ward mission plan
3. Help organizing monthly service opportunities
4. Attend weekly huddles and then help put the plan into action
